

Fall/Winter sales

To determine if your clothing is appropriate for fall/winter, ask yourself:

- Is it available in the stores for full price in September? Can this be worn in December?

Accepted for fall/winter sales:

- Short-sleeved shirts if dark colors
- All long-sleeved shirts and sweaters
- All pants
- Jeans
- Dark-colored or winter fabric capris
- Skirts—styles/fabrics that are appropriate for fall/winter
- Dresses—styles/fabrics that are appropriate for fall/winter
- Shoes—everything except what's listed below
- Coats/Jackets--all
- Accessories—gloves, mittens, scarves, hats, bows, belts, etc.
- Costumes

Not accepted for fall/winter sales:

- Short-sleeved white or pastel colored shirts
- Sleeveless or cap sleeved shirts
- White/light-colored capris
- Shorts
- Swimsuits
- Shoes—sandals, flip-flops, water shoes

Spring/Summer sales

To determine if your clothing is appropriate for spring/summer, ask yourself:

- Is it available in the stores for full price in March? Can this be worn in June?

Accepted for spring/summer:

- All short-sleeved, sleeveless and cap sleeved shirts
- Long-sleeved shirts if white/pastel; could be worn on Easter
- Easter-type sweaters
- All shorts
- All spring/summer fabric capris
- Swimsuits
- Jeans
- Shoes—everything except what's listed below

Not accepted for spring/summer:

- No long-sleeved shirts, except what's listed above
- Capris or pants that are fall/winter fabrics
- Shoes—no boots
