GUIDELINES

The tag must disclose all of the information so the shopper can make an informed decision. Specifically:

- Choose the size for the tag that best describes how the item fits
- If the manufacturer size is different from the size you choose, you must note that in the description.

- At drop-off, hang the item on the rack in the size you chose in the drop-down menu.
- Please note that 24 month and 2T are different sizes as are 4 & 4T, 5 & 5T and 6 & 6X
- If the clothing is labeled in a range (3-6 month, e.g.), you can tag it in EITHER size depending on how you think it fits (i.e. 3 month OR 6 month), but in the description you need to make note of it. (Gap 3-6 month)
- DO NOT hand write on tags
- All clothing must have the manufacturer's size tag. No handmade clothing will be accepted.
